Wireman's Training Course

Documents required:

- 1) Letter addressed to the Chief of Training EWA with the candidate's Name, CPR No, Mobile No., and work experience, signed by the company Owner or Director with the company stamp.
- 2) Download form from EWA website, fill all data & attach scan copies of below.
- 3) Qualification Certificate, photocopy attested & signed by the company owner
- 4) Qualification must be Tawjihi /Diploma /ITI /BSc/ BE, in **Electrical** (Only)
- 5) CPR Smartcard printout (dated within 7 days) with clear photo
- 6) Scan color Photo 30 x 35 on white background
- Qualifications: Electrical Engineering Only from a **Government or State Approved** Institute (Level 5 NQF).
- Bahraini must be registered in the Ministry of Labor if unemployed on the date of application submission
- For Bahraini Nationals the minimum accepted qualification is the Tawjihi (Electrical) certificate.
- All Candidates must be over 18 years of age and less than 70 as license will automatically expire after 70 years of age

Fees:- 350 BD

Fee to repeat the written Exam - 10 BD

Fee (paid to EWA) to repeat the Practical Exam - 20 BD

Wireman Training Application Procedure: - After approval of all submitted documentation: -

- Candidates attend the training and written examination on the date specified
- Successful candidates will then be notified of the date for the practical test.
- In case of not being able to attend the test on the assigned date, the Training section must be informed in writing at least one week before the test date. Failure to do so will result in loss of fees, and the re-application for a new test date upon re-payment of the appropriate fee. Successful candidates will be issued with the Electrical Wireman's License valid for five (5) years. This test will be conducted in either Arabic or English
